OPEN ACCESS POLICIES OF ACTA MEDICA GRUPO ANGELES

Creative Commons Licenses

Creative Commons (CC) licenses are free legal tools that allow users (licensees) to use copyrighted works without requesting permission from the author, the Society, or the publishing house.

The *Acta Médica* journal and the material published within it are licensed under the Creative Commons: **Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives (CC BY-NC-ND)** license.

This license allows users to copy and distribute the material in any medium or format, without modifying it, solely for non-commercial purposes and provided that appropriate credit is given to the creator. CC BY-NC-ND includes the following elements:

BY: Credit must be given to the creator.

NC: Only non-commercial uses of the work are permitted. **ND**: No derivatives or adaptations of the work are allowed.

All articles submitted for publication are analyzed using the plagiarism detection software Safe Assignment (TEC).

EDITORIAL PROCESSING FEE FOR ARTICLES

The editorial processing of articles (from submission to publication) does not involve any charge or fee for the author.
