Compliance with Ethical Guidelines. Plagiarism and use of Gen AI will be sufficient cause for not publishing the article.

Conflict of Interest: Conflict of interest statements should list each author separately by name.

Example:

Jorge Perez declares that he has no conflict of interest. Mario Hernandez has received research grants from Company A.

Jose Rodriguez has received speaker honoraria from Company B and owns stock in Company C.

If multiple authors declare that there is no conflict, this can be done in one sentence: Jorge Ramos, Sergio Marquez, and Jorge Martinez declare that they have no conflict of interest.

For studies involving human subjects, include the following:

All procedures followed were in accordance with the ethical standards of the Committee on Human Experimentation (institutional or national) and with the 1975 Declaration of Helsinki, as revised in 2000. State that informed consent was obtained from all patients for inclusion in the study. If there is any doubt about whether the research was conducted in accordance with the Declaration of Helsinki, the authors should

justify their approach to the institutional review board and attach documentation that the board explicitly approved the questionable aspects of the study.

The article should not include any identifying information about patients. A copy of the protocol approved by the institutional research committee or, failing that, authorization from the Hospital's Teaching Department must be submitted. If the authors are involved in outpatient studies, the researcher must send a letter informing the authors of this situation and stating that all ethical standards for publication have been met.

For studies involving animals, the following sentence should be included:

It is hereby acknowledged that all institutional and national guidelines for the care and use of laboratory animals were followed.

For articles that do not contain studies with human subjects or animals performed by any of the authors, we recommend including the following sentence, just to ensure that readers are aware that there are no ethical issues with humans or animals:

"This article does not contain any studies with human subjects or animals performed by any of the authors."
