Acta Médica Grupo Angeles is committed to the creation, preservation, standardization, and dissemination of high-quality metadata for all published content. The metadata provided include: title, English title, authors' full names, institutional affiliations, ORCID identifiers, abstract, keywords, DOI, dates of submission, acceptance, and publication, volume, issue, page numbers, and bibliographic references.

This policy applies to all journal content and aims to enhance the visibility, discoverability, interoperability, and indexing of published articles across national and international scientific information systems.

The journal adheres to internationally recognized standards for bibliographic description and metadata interoperability, including Crossref, DOI, and ORCID. Metadata are available for harvesting through the OAI-PMH protocol.

All metadata are provided in open access to facilitate the identification, discovery, retrieval, preservation, dissemination, and indexing of the scientific content published by the journal.

The editorial team is responsible for the review, validation, and standardization of metadata to ensure their accuracy, consistency, completeness, and quality.
